



Patient Instructions

<u>For All Patients:</u>

- Abstain from ejaculation for at least 48 hours prior to semen collection. Abstaining beyond seven days is also not recommended.
- If the sample is to be collected at home, please use a clean or sterile plastic container with a top [available at referring physician's office or from Specialists In Reproductive Medicine & Surgery, P.A., (SRMS)]. All specimen containers must be properly labeled with the patient's name, date and time of collection.
- After collection, the sample should be kept at body temperature and not be warmed or cooled during transport.
- The sample needs to arrive at SRMS within 45 minutes of collection. If this time constraint is not convenient, private facilities are available at SRMS. *Discretion and privacy are our highest priorities*.
- Please bring this prescription with you on the day of testing/semen preparation.
- Payment is due at the time services are rendered, unless we participate in your health care plan and the specific tests and procedures are covered under your plan. Please call our business office at (239) 275-8118 when you receive this prescription so that all financial questions can be answered prior to the services being rendered.

Semen Analysis Patients Only:

- Please follow instructions "**For All Patients**" as listed above.
- Semen analysis results will be sent to the referring clinician within three business days. Please call this clinician for interpretation of the lab results.
- Please call SRMS at least two days prior to semen collection to schedule the tests at (239) 275-8118.

<u>Remote Semen Preparation (RSP) Service for Insemination (IUI) Patients:</u>

- Please follow instructions "For All Patients" as listed above.
- In the IUI procedure, your semen is specially prepared to increase sperm concentration, motility and normal sperm forms. This prepared sperm is then placed into the uterine cavity to maximize conception potential.
- All IUI semen preparation procedures must be scheduled by Noon of the previous day. All semen preparation procedures are available seven days each week.
- Financial issues must be discussed before services are rendered. This is particularly important for weekend and holiday semen preparation procedures.
- SRMS has a special container that will be used to transport the prepared sperm from SRMS to your physician's office. Please keep your container and bring it with you each time the semen is prepared.
- Additional information regarding the IUI process can be obtained from SRMS by request and is also available for download at the **www.DreamAßaby.com** web site. Your partner's clinician should also be able to answer your questions.

<u>Cryopreservation of Sperm Patients:</u>

- Please follow instructions "**for All Patients**" as listed above.
- A consultation with a SRMS Reproductive Endocrinologist is required before any sperm are cryopreserved.
- A complete packet of information regarding the cryopreservation process should be picked up (or can be mailed upon request) and reviewed prior to your consultation.
