Therapeutic Donor Insemination Patient Checklist

Trying to Make This Less Complicated!

In an attempt to make this a bit less complicated, we recommend the following:

- Read your packet at least twice!
- Your history and physical exam must be up-to-date with SRMS.
- Make certain your laboratory testing and other procedures are completed to be certain that you are a candidate for donor sperm.
- If you have a partner, please also obtain the necessary laboratory testing.
- Visit the [Fairfax Cryobank](http://www.fairfaxcryobank.com/index.cfm) web site (<http://www.fairfaxcryobank.com/index.cfm>) for additional information.
- Sign all consents!
- Choose your top five sperm donors and notify SRMS of your choices in order of desire.
- Pre-payment is required for all donor sperm prior to ordering the sperm from Fairfax.
- Notify SRMS when you start your menstrual period so that they can make certain that your donor sperm has arrived. If you are taking additional medications for the TDI/IUI process, make sure these are purchased ahead of time.
- Unless it is a covered service, pre-payment for the TDI/IUI procedure itself is required without exception. It is your responsibility to find out if it is a covered service. It will be assumed to be uncovered unless your insurance company otherwise notifies us.
- Purchase the urine test kits. These kits are only available at specific pharmacies.
- Start testing your urine for the LH surge. Notify SRMS when this occurs.
- Make sure that the General & Monthly Consent Form is signed for each month you undergo the TDI procedure.
